These people are creative. One person had me hanging from like a sky, I don't know, I can't think of the word, it's a plane but it was not just a plane, it was crazy. - Like a biplane? - Like a plane, it looks like I was one of the trailer things from the lane and somebody's flying by, like it was the flat Marly, and then somebody put my face on some monuments and stuff and it says that people shouldn't climb but you can't keep Marly off of it. It's hilarious, and then this one girl, I know, so funny, this one little girl, she colored, she couldn't get it to print so she hand drew one and colored it. I'm telling you, I have the best people! - I'm jealous. - They're so fantastic. -

What do I have to be do to made into flat Faith and have my picture taken on monuments? - Send me your Bitmoji, I'll have Caitlyn make you a flat Faith. (laughs) Anyways, I'm sorry, that totally took a tangent. Yeah, there you go. - Which is to say, we really appreciate Marly's minions, you guys are obviously amazing creative geniuses. - Yes they are, they're fantastic. - So look book is a collection of patterns? - Collection of patterns. - [Faith] That highlight the newest yarns. - [Marly] So let's talk about the word hygge in general. - Okay. - So I'm gonna bring over this - What's hygge? - [Marly] So hygge, hygge is spelled H-Y-G-G-E and it's a Danish word meaning coziness or comfort or wellbeing. So it's sort of like this sense of oh my gosh, this whole atmosphere, this whole environment is so hygge, it's so cozy, comfy, squishy, and so Red Heart loved that term, loved the concept of it so they came out with a yarn called hygge and this stuff is, it's so fantastic, 'cause I have a scarf on that I made with it. - [Faith] It's so soft. - [Marly] It's incredibly soft, it has this nice - Cozy - [Marly] Kind of, it's not eyelash, but what would you call it, it kind of resembles eyelash, but it's like bits that kind of come off. It just makes you feel like it's super cozy. - [Faith] It's really soft. - [Marly] It's really, really soft. It's machine washable, it just feels really good. It comes in 20 beautiful, muted sort of colors and I just, I love it. So this is kind of the starting point for it. So this is the original hygge yarn. And then we also have hygge charm is a little bit more sleek than the hygge, right, 'cause this one's really furry. This one's a little bit more sleek but you can see it kind of has this really great sparkle hint to it. Again, it's really nice and soft, it comes in really nice put ups, I mean it's 432 yards - Lot of yardage - [Marly] Yeah, right? And it's just really nice. Again, wonderful palette. This one I think has 14 colors, it might, I think it's 14, yeah, I think it's 14 colors. Really similar as far as shades and stuff and it's just really beautiful, right? So this kind of goes along with the whole idea of the hygge, hyggeness of it all, right? - [Faith] Sure. - So with this in mind, we've come up with a look book. So our team at Red Heart, they're fantastic when it comes to putting together designs and working with designers with the concept of what they have. So they have this concept of hygge and the yarns that they have that kind of give the, whether they are hygge themselves or the concept of hygge, and they've put together some fantastic patterns with this whole idea of comfort and cozy. Perfect time right here in fall. We just had the autumnal equinox. Say that three times fast, right? - I can't. (laughs) - And so there it is, so let's kinda talk about that if that's alright - Awesome - Yeah, is that good? Any questions about hygge? I feel like I'm teaching a class. Are there any questions? - Please, we are live, so if you have questions, you can ask them below. - Yes, alright, so the first thing we're gonna talk about is the corner-to-corner guest throw and that's this piece right here, and this is made using our new yarn called Dreamy. I think we've talked about Dreamy on here before with you. It's sort of like a brushed acrylic, very soft, very comfortable, very cozy, very easy to work with. I didn't find that my needle or my hook got caught in it and please forgive me, I'm not a loom knitter or I'm not a weaver either so I'm just gonna, my reference is the hook or needle. Like I didn't have any trouble with it. When I work with mohair and stuff, sometimes I have little issue, didn't have any problem when I worked with this, and so the idea about the guest throw is when you have company over, whether it's during any time of the year or especially during the holiday season, you want them to feel comfortable and welcomed in their guest room, right? So maybe you have a specific guest throw that you have in there and it's supposed to be really nice, comfortable, and cozy with the hygge theme. It's a basic corner-to-corner throw so you start at the corner and you work your way up just like any other basic corner-to-corner. No color changes, 'cause we just let the yarn do what it's gonna do. You could change this up and use Dreamy Stripes 'cause there's a Dreamy Stripes yarn and get some stripes if you wanted to, but there's something really soothing about the muted nature of this color. And then it's finished off with this really

beautiful, delicate trim, right? And so it's just a nice little touch to add to your guest room and if you love them enough, you could also send them home with this guest throw and kind of have them have this memory of their time at your house - So special - [Marly] Bring that coziness back home with them, right? - [Faith] I think of this yarn as like frosted yarn. - [Marly] Yes. - [Faith] Just a little bit blurry. - It's just, I love it. It's just so beautiful. I'm making a sweater out of this right now, a sweater design. - Like a big collar? - Yes, yes, that's exactly what I'm doing. - Awesome. - Yes, just 'cause that, it screams that to me. - Yeah. - Needs to do that - Me too - Right? - That's wild. - But I love this idea. This was such a good idea I think. It's outside the box of just making a basic blanket. - [Faith] My mind is still boggled too because I've done a lot of knitting corner to corner and that's fairly obvious but this, the stitches are going this way and the stitches are going this way, so it still, it looks, - [Marly] Yeah, but you make it diagonal. - That's so cool. - [Marly] Corner to corner's so fun, it so fun. - [Faith] Gotta do it. - Yeah, so that is the guest corner-to-corner throw. I'm curious how many of you out there would actually make a throw to keep in your guest room and then would you give it away to your guests or would you say no, no, no, I'm keeping, sorry, you can't have that, you know? I'm just kinda curious how many of you, because we were discussing that here. I think I would let them take it, if I loved them enough, if I loved them enough. Now my friends are like who does she love enough? (laughs) You know? - Cold - I know. - None of you are getting throws. - So one of my favorite designers, Sandy Rosner designed this next piece and it's called the Safe Haven Shawl. It is just a basic rectangular shawl and it's knit with this really, would you call this like a waffly type of stitch? - [Faith] Sure. - [Marly] It's not a seed stitch but it has sort of like a broken rib waffle. - [Faith] It's almost like a thermal rib. - [Marly] Yeah, it just, it screams coziness to me, just the stitch pattern itself that she used. This is the hygge charm yarn that we talked about where it's the nice solid yarn then with the nice sparkle that's kinda wrapped in there, so you get the really nice squishiness, right, the squishy - The squish - [Marly] As you wrap up, maybe as you're snuggling up on the couch with a cup of tea and a good book. - [Faith] It entirely matches my sweater. - Oh I know, you could totally pull this off. And it just, it just feels really good. It feels nice, and it's not too heavy, you know? With the 100% acrylic you might think oh, I don't know, that might be too heavy. No, it's really nice and soft - Perfect. - Isn't that great? - I do like the idea of something screaming cozy, 'cause cozy to me is like a low-volume situation. - Yes, yes. - Cozy! - That's exactly, screaming cozy, low-volume situation. Yeah, you're right. And this is easy, again that's knit very basic, you just need to know basic knits and purls to be able to complete that and you'd have no problem. - So simple. - It's so simple, and I love Sandy. That's what I love about Sandy, some of her patterns are just the simplicity of them but they are absolutely beautiful. You got it? Alright, so this one isn't gonna show up well in the picture here but we've got it here in person. So this is the Knit Nesting Throw and oh my gosh, can we just talk for a minute about the yarn? - [Faith] It's sumptuous. - [Marly] Oh my gosh, so I mean, we go into different, I don't know we, me, I will go into Pottery Barn, or Crate and Barrel or all of those sort of high-end sort of stores and you always see the furniture with this really beautiful throw just kind of, just over the back of the chair, right - Effortlessly - [Marly] This totally reminds me of one of those. - [Faith] This is that throw. - [Marly] Yeah, it is that throw. The yarn is the hygge, the actual hygge yarn. It is so soft and squishy, you just wanna snuggle up in this. - [Faith] It's really snuggly. - [Marly] It is a take on a basket weave, right, it's a basket weave, it looks like these are a little bit wider than these so it's just a little bit, little bit different. - [Faith] It's unbelievably soft. - Right? - Yes. - [Marly] I wish you guys could feel this - I wanna rub it - through the camera - [Faith] Not just squeeze it - [Marly] Because it just feels so good. Like I wanna wrap up in this and watch football and you know, just have some nachos or

something. It just feels really good, have a fire going. I love that they chose the white to make this, but you could use any of the colors. There is a braided knit throw, if you look on the ball band here, that one right there? - [Faith] So pretty. - [Marly] It's with this color and it is stunning 'cause it's like kind of the purply-gray. Oh my gosh it is so pretty, but you can make this with that, I mean it would just absolutely just make up any sort of comfortable - I love it - [Marly] Area, right? - [Faith] How many balls does this take? - [Marly] That is a very good question. It says nine balls. Nine balls of the color pearl, nine balls. - [Faith] Just gonna hold it. - You just wanna hold it, isn't that great? - Yes. - Like it's fantastic, it's one of those things where you take it out of, for when we got this, you take it out of the box, you're like oh my gosh, what is this? It just screams to all of your tactileness. - I wanna keep all of these. (laughs) - It's really awesome. Well just a couple more. You ready? - Yep. - Alright, so one of the big things lately that Red Heart is trying to do is trying to incorporate more craft into some of their patterns. So we have the Braided Harmony Wall Hanging. So you know you have maybe a really soothing environment, you maybe have made this blanket, you have this shawl, so now you have the wall hanging and this is made with the Dreamy yarn, so this is the Red Heart Dreamy yarn again, and it's just wrapped around a dowel and then there's a couple pieces here that are braided. I mean, very simple but it's a way to incorporate some of this nice, cozy texture in with it all. I know it came with a hanger thing but I can't find it, it's just a piece of string. - [Faith] And this is, we have our own non-knitter or crocheter yarn aficionado in-house. - Yes - Miss Courtney Cerutti - [Marly] She's fantastic, I love her. - [Faith] And she loves yarn banners and yarn craft of all types so I bet she'd love this one. - [Marly] Right, it just, don't you wanna - [Faith] I can't stop touching it, I'm so sorry. Even your sweater's soft. (laughs) - No, I do, I love this, I do this to my daughter's hair all the time, you know? I'll go like this, that just makes me happy. - We have a question. - Yes. - [Ally] Jennifer wants to know what the blanket was called again? - Jennifer is wondering what the blanket is called again. - And that is the Knit Nesting Throw. - Knit Nesting Throw - Knit Nesting Throw, and all these patterns are available in the look book over at redheart.com. They're all free, and then I know that Red Heart right now if you guys are watching right now, I think they're having a sale on their website, just FYI, if you get the yarn, just throwin' that out there. We all like a good sale, right? - Love a sale. - Take a look, doesn't hurt to go take a peek. Alright, so this one is cool, alright? Not gonna lie, Marly's minions know I have a soft place in my heart for eyelash-sort of yarn, like I still own bins of it, and so when Red Heart came out with the Fur yarn, it is, full on looks like fur. It just, right, this is like eyelash on crack. It is fur, and so I saw this piece and I'm like oh, I've gotta have that. It's just a basic rectangle but it's one of those pieces that you can just throw on a chair, lay it out as a rug, it is so soft. - It's really thick. - [Marly] Right? It is fur, I mean it is so thick and so comfortable. - [Faith] But vegan. - [Marly] Yes, it is vegan. (laughs) But isn't this awesome? - [Faith] This feels like when I'm on my couch. - [Marly] Yeah, it's nice, right? It's so nice and to me I bet this is garter stitch, I bet if we look, yeah, it's knit every row. So it's just garter stitch. The hardest part I think would be just paying attention to make sure you don't accidentally drop a stitch 'cause if you did that, you're in trouble. That thing is just gone. - [Faith] Is the yarn doubled or is this, - [Marly] It looks like it might be, yes, it's With Love and Fur. With Love and Fur - So thick. - [Marly] Yeah. - [Faith] It is very ruglike. - Doesn't that feel good? - Yes - [Marly] So this is one of those things that you could absolutely see in one of those stylish magazines like my mom likes to get, she gets all those magazines - Yes - [Marly] For all the decorator stuff. Like I could totally see this, just thrown over something, just real cozy - Draped - [Marly] Yeah. - [Ally] I have to butt in. Ursula has a great idea. She said I want to knit that in the shape of a sheepskin rug. - Ursula our CEO says she wants to knit this in the shape of a sheepskin rug. Ursula, you're brilliant. - I think Ursula needs to do

that, I think that's her next thing. I love it, I think it's just so comfortable. It just makes me happy. This makes me - I'm getting drowsy. - [Marly] This makes me so happy. I love this so much, I could totally see this, even make this a little bit longer and double it up and like a body pillow cover or something, right? - Speaking of - Speaking of - You guys wanna see something neat? So you all know there's like this huge craze on really big, bulky yarn, right? Red Heart Irresistible has been going like gangbusters now for over a year. It's the really big, thick yarn. My mom and I did a video for the wonderful Big Stitch Throw using this yarn, it's just really great yarn, uses big needles and it's fun. So the Red Heart Team came out with a really fun project called Good Night's Sleep Body Pillow made with the Red Heart Irresistible yarn and this thing is fantastic. Look at this, oh my gosh, I love it. I love it so much. I love the little fringe at the end, I love everything about this, like it's just brilliant. - When we pulled it out of the box, several people went (whimpered) and ran towards it and grabbed it. You wanna hold it with both hands. - [Marly] Right? - [Faith] You wanna embrace it. - It's squishy, it's squishy, I love this. So this is a really fun, wonderful project and you wanna talk about instant gratification? This thing would get really quickly 'cause it's really big yarn, big needles. Let's see what size needles, size 50 needles, I mean come on, that's speed knitting right there. - [Faith] That's wacky. - It's pretty cool - It's wonderful. - I love it, so that's it, that's the look book. I wanna know what your favorites are. What are some of your favorites that we've shown you today? - Oh, and, since you waited so patiently, I mean not that that was an unpleasant wait, it was the coziest experience of my life, but we'd like to show you the Super Slouch Cardigan by Ms. Marly Bird. And this is the class that's releasing tomorrow, and tell the people about this cardigan. - About the cardigan? So what's kinda funny is, - [Faith] Do you want me to tell them about it? - [Marly] No, I can tell them, let me tell them the story of it. So Caitlyn has been asking me forever to make a cardigan, make a sweater, and so when Creative Bug was like hey, we want you to come teach a class, I was like cool. They're like we want a sweater. I said great, Caitlyn's gonna be so happy! And so I came up with a sweater pattern that's, it's inside out, I'm absolutely going to say I think you guys will love. It uses very simple stitches, we're looking at the back, I think if you guys have it on the overhead. This is the back of the piece, right? Did I turn it inside out or did I not? I thought I did. Anyways, regardless, this is the back of the piece. It has some really simple wonderful stitches, use really easy stitches and this is just on the back. When you get to the top part and the sleeves, it's just in double crochet and just really easy. Or is it half double? - Double. - [Marly] Double. - So this is if you are, if you can make a couple of crochet stitches but you haven't extended far beyond that, this is an ideal first sweater project. It looks harder than it is and the class, I helped on the class, so it feels funny to brag about it but it's like an impeccable class, like everything you need to know is contained, well we always have everything you need to know contained in the class, but I feel it's succinct, you say okay, now you do your thing and come back and see me when you're done, and you have plenty of time to breathe - Yeah - And to work on the stitches, it's just, and the finished project is amazing. - [Marly] Yeah, and there's very little seaming 'cause it's all one piece, you know, it's all done in one piece. You have the side seams here. - [Faith] It's so, so simple. - [Marly] The trim edging part is very, it's just very easy. I think you were right, I think you did have it right, I don't know, regardless. It's reversible. (laughs) - I would never correct you. - Don't quote me on that. - In front of the minions. (laughs) I don't need them coming for me. - It's been a long day. But it's so pretty and it's one of those pieces, it's meant to be oversized and because of the wool aspect of the yarn, it holds its shape really well the more you wear it. It's just, it's just fun, it's fun. - And if you're interested in winning enough yarn to make this whole sweater or two sizes larger than it, please like, comment, share, and enter the Rafflecopter. minutes? - I'm good - We've got a couple more minutes. - I'm good, I'm gonna fix it 'cause I made it wrong side. You were correct. - I mean listen, you're the boss. - Hey, I just was looking at it goofy. You're good, we're good now. It's beautiful, it's beautiful. - It's really nice - And this - Do you like it? - I love it, I love it, are you kidding? I put it on on the way up the stairs and then I had to take it off to be professional. - [Marly] I love it. - [Faith] Not that I haven't put on everything else I've taken out so far. - Do you wanna show them, so this is the hygge yarn, I pulled it out and I was like, because I didn't know if people would be curious about how well you can crochet with it because it is a little fuzzy, and it's really not that difficult at all, so I've just done some treble crochets here and you're gonna see, I just pulled one out but it's as simple as just having kind of a big, bulky yarn, you just find your spot where you go and you just create your stitch, pretty easy. - [Faith] Tell me about what you're wearing. - Oh, this is, so you know that braided, this piece right here, this braided throw that I showed you that's on the packaging? So this scarf started out as the swatch for the YouTube video that I did for that knit throw and I was like gosh, I loved making that so much, so I extended out how far apart I made the cables and I just made it into a scarf, 'cause I love it so much, and so it's just a free pattern on my website, and it's two balls and it's funny 'cause this yarn there's a lot of give to it and it's like size 15 needles I think made this. - Oh wow. - Yeah, and so there's a lot of give to the yarn, it has a lot of play to it, so two balls was more than enough to finish this whole thing and so I've been wearing it all day 'cause it's nice and cool and Dunmore this morning when I left and it's just, it feels really good. - [Faith] Color's really nice. - [Marly] I like it. - This is the portion of the segment, the segment of the portion that we're calling Stitch and Chat with Marly Bird. - Stitch and Chat. - So if you haven't been working on your project until now, now's the time, we're just gonna hang out, we're gonna hang out for a few more minutes. - So anyways, this is a free pattern on my website, you can absolutely get it there. - And what is your website? - Marlybird.com. - Perfect - And if people don't like ads in their patterns and stuff, we also sell an ad-free version so there's, so people sometimes will get on Ravelry and be like oh wait, it says it's for purchase. It's like no, there's a free pattern out there for sure, the link is in the description, but for people who are like you know what? I just want a nice, pretty PDF, I'll just buy it. - That's a good idea. - Yeah, a lot of people enjoy doing that so we incorporated that into the business several years ago, 'cause people enjoy having that option - Sure - So I just try and make everybody happy, doing what I can. - That's why you're the best. - [Marly] I know, right? Can we just have an appreciation for this color? It reminds me of toffee. - Wheatgrass - [Marly] Like Heath bars are my favorite, like this reminds me of the inside of a Heath bar. - Did you have Score bars? - Oh, those were so good - Those were my favorite. - I love those. Those are tasty. - I was introduced to those by my high school boyfriend John Hannigan and he gave me like a bouquet of them for Valentine's Day. - That's funny. - Good job, John Hannigan. (laughs) - That's hilarious. How are things going over there, Ally? - [Ally] They're going great. - Lots of Marly love? - So our longtime Creative Bug Facebook attendees will notice that our moderator Ally is back. - Yay! - She was gone for a few months on maternity leave and she's back and we couldn't be happier. - Hi everyone! - We missed her - I missed you very much - [Faith] We missed her and she's missed you so feel free to show her some love in the comments. - [Marly] So happy. - [Faith] Baby Ben is doing great. - Had I known I was on camera I would've put on makeup, so everyone at home doesn't see how tired I look. - [Faith] She looks great. - [Marly] She looks fantastic and her - So good to be back, hi guys. - Your baby is beautiful. - He is, he's all cheeks. - Adorable, like so cute. - Every time he comes into the office too everyone has to give him a little smooch. - Yeah? Can I just tell you that I curled my hair today with a flat iron? Like I've never used one before and so I curled it and it went ding-ding-ding and I go ooh, I look like Faith. I'm

gonna do that all over. So I curled it all over but then you can see - Why didn't you do the bangs? - No, my bangs are so long, like they, it was not pretty, but I tried to have it all curly and it feels like it's going all straight. But I tried to be like you today, so - Well tell me next time and I'll straighten it. - Okay! - I actually haven't since I got these things. - Yeah, I love your hair. - Thank you so much - It's awesome. - I hung out with some friends from Vogue Knitting. - I wanted to ask you - Over the weekend - About that! - So fun - So those of you who don't know, Faith and I have literally been friends since we both started in this industry. Like years and years ago when I first started the Yarn Thing Podcast and Faith was working at Vogue Knitting, like years ago, and so when she came to work here - It was a long time - It was like, she goes hey do you remember me? I'm like Faith, I do remember you! And so it's just been fun. - Yeah. - Anyways, go on with your story now. - No, that's, (laughs) so I used to work for Vogue Knitting and they have an event they call VK Live and it's all over the country and this past one was in San Francisco so I stopped by and I actually got to help with the fashion show, it was really fun. - That's cool. - Yeah, but they haven't seen me since the bangs and some people didn't recognize me. - Really, that's shocking. - I was shocked. - That's crazy. - I also was wearing a blazer. - Oh. - [Ally] Well then people were definitely like who is this woman (laughs) - Very confusing. - Imposter. - [Ally] Alright, we have a question from Phil. I love this. Phil is wondering, Marly and Faith, you're allowed one cozy item in your hygge emergency kit, only one. What do you choose? - Phil says, Phil is the best and we love him, hi Phil, and his question is we have only one hygge item in our emergency cozy kit, what is it? Socks. - Socks? - I'm wearing socks right now that are falling down and it's making me existential. - You know what?
